03 PRACTICUM

Our high-quality on-site practicum experience in a clinical setting boasts doctoral level faculty supervisors that work closely with you to prepare you to become an exceptional supervisor and skilled clinician. Our Early Intensive Behavior Intervention (EIBI) is a highly structured and evidence-based behavioral program for young children with neurodevelopmental disabilities. This program offer one-to-one, individualized treatment that focuses on skill acquisition.

Year one: practicum experience will consist of implementing programs, collecting data and monitoring programs.

Year two: practicum experience will shift to skills that closely align to your responsibilities as a behavior analyst, these include: staff training, formal monitoring, assessment and program development.

Students will receive additional experience in treating food selectivity, developing comprehensive behavior plans for inappropriate behaviors (e.g., aggression, self-injury, elopement), and community training.
