## **Clinical Program Costs**

### **Assistantships & Fellowships:**

The department offers financial aid to all qualified applicants in the form of NIH research traineeships\*, research assistantships, teaching assistantships, or university fellowships. Stipends range from \$16,500 (9-month) to \$22,000 (12-month) for the academic year plus full tuition remission. Sources of summer funding are also available.

\*The Department has 5 federally funded research training grants that support graduate students in the child, health, and adult areas.

### **Tuition Remission:**

All full-time students in the Ph.D. program receive full tuition remission. Students are responsible for mandatory and optional fees each semester as well as for all course materials (e.g., books, supplies).

### **Other Support:**

Limited financial support for graduate student research and for travel to scientific/professional meetings for paper/poster presentations is available to students each year.

\*This fee is automatically charged to a student's account each semester, but can be waived.

\*\*This fee can be waived if a student shows proof of health insurance coverage from another agency.

### **Tuition:**

Although all our students receive tuition remission, if students were responsible for paying tuition, the costs would be as follows:
